In 2003, Visión México established a partnership with the Coca-Cola Foundation, creating a 5-year financial commitment to rehabilitate approximately 20 shelters per year.

A grant was given to Vamos Mexico to refurbished boarding schools. The following is being done to the schools:

Regular maintenance work completed

Installation of utility services such as electricity, clean water and telephone lines that can be used for Internet connections

Instructional materials

Computers and video resources

Recreational facilities

In design and curriculum, these schools honor the distinctive and proud culture of Mexico's indigenous rural population. Because the shelters operate in remote areas, several logistical considerations had to be addressed.

The number of community members benefited from the Boarding School Program went up from 12,024 in 2002 to 168,871 in 2003.
