Through linking and connections to transform lives, Fundación Vamos México and our team serve citizens who seek support, guidance, or channeling to other foundations. In June, we attended 24 requests related to health issues, of which 10 were supported directly, and 14 were channeled to other institutions and foundations with which we collaborate.

To prepare for the future, 17 young students from low resource communities will visit the University of San Diego, California (UCSD), to experience an intensive academic program called "Academic Connections". During this program they will partake in bilingual classes of literature and writing, participate in extracurricular activities, have access to the computer facilities (library, research centers, sports areas, etc), and visit San Diego, California, to connect with other students from the United States and the world.

Serving citizens

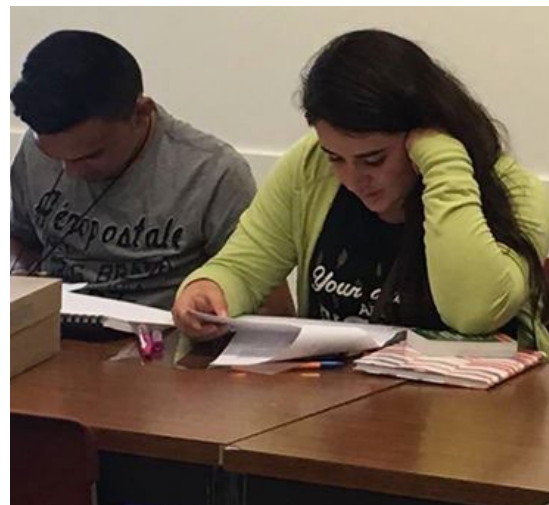
Fundación Vamos México and our team serve citizens who seek support, guidance, or channeling to other foundations. In June, we attended 24 requests related to health issues, of which 10 were supported directly, and 14 were channeled to other institutions and foundations with which we collaborate. Due to the need and demand of services of those who come to Fundación, starting this month, we will have the support of two psychologists to attend the situations that require the attention of these professionals. With the addition to our team, we will be able to strengthen the support and care we provide to young people, children, and adults who visit us from nearby communities. We successfully concluded the workshop provided by the Centro de Integración Juvenil (Center for Youth Integration) to the children who currently participate in the Centro Fox's Music School.

Community development

17 young students from low resource communities will visit the University of San Diego, California to experience an intensive academic program called "Academic Connections", which objective is to change the students' perspectives through education and life experiences. During this visit the students will interact with other American and foreign students, participate in a bilingual course regarding literature, visit tourist sports in San Diego, and have access to all campus facilities. UCSD has been ranked as the 17th best university in the world.

The program "Academic Connections" of the University of San Diego, will receive approximately 400 students from 20 US states and 7 countries, including for the first time Mexico. The cost of the program is \$3,800 USD, equivalent to \$64,600 MXN, including airfare, visa formalities and transport. It should be noted that the students were given a full ride scholarship by Fundación Vamos México, with the support of Reality Changers, UCSD, and the foundation Volaris.

In the sports and leadership program, we counted with 60 students in the Soccer School and 80 students in the Weekend League, belonging to the communities of Santa Rita, San Judas, Rancho Nuevo, Plan Libertador, Nuevo Jesús del Monte, San Cristóbal, La Sandía, El Capricho and El Desagüe. We held activities for over 80 older adults from the communities nearby to San Cristóbal, including lectures, physical activities, and literacy consulting, elementary and secondary courses with instructors



from the INEA. As part of the program of addiction prevention, 3 workshops regarding violence prevention were held for the parents of the students who attend the Centro Fox's Music School, 2 workshops at the Centro de Integración Juvenil, and 1 orientation workshop for the parents and children who attend middle school.

CRISMA

We are excited to report that this month our fundraising program "Apadrina un Niño" (Godfather a Child) welcomed a new donor. Your generosity will fill the hearts of our children and families with joy, as all contributions support the professional rehabilitation of children living in poverty and suffering from a physical or neurological disability.

53 patients received services in Pediatric Rehabilitation, providing 567 therapy sessions, 32 patients received services in Physical Rehabilitation, providing 165 therapy sessions, and 39 patients received services in Language and Communication, providing 121 therapy sessions.

At CRISMA we are aware that not all can reach our facilities, through CRISMA's "Community Campaign" we go to them. This month we visited the communities of Cruz del Palmar, Puerto de Nieto, La Talega, and San Miguelito, where 100 tests were applied, of which 29 were cases in which therapy would be needed.
